## **VOLLEYBALL REGULATIONS**

Last update 25-04-2008

# 1. Organization

- a. The Volleyball Committee of the 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah will be responsible for the Volleyball competitions of the 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.
- b. The Volleyball competitions will be conducted according to the last up to date rules of the International Volleyball Federation, the English text will be binding.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any sportsman who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee of the 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah and registered the Volleyball competitions.
- d. Each country may enter one team for the men Volleyball competitions, one team for the women's Volleyball competitions, and one team for the girls Junior (1991-1994) Volleyball competitions.
- e. Each team may consist of 12 players only.

### 2. Venues and times

- a. The Volleyball Committee of the 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah will determine the venues and times of the Volleyball competitions and teams will be notified accordingly.
- b. The Volleyball Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions. These decisions will be final.

# 3. Game ball

- a. The games will be played with Molten balls.
- b. The Volleyball Committee is authorized to change the brand name of balls, if necessary, and these decisions will be final.

## 4. System of competition

SYSTEM A - with the participation of up to 7 teams;

- a. The competitions will be played on a league basis of a single round robin league system.
- b. The winner of each game will be awarded two points, the loser one point. For a technical loss no points will be awarded.
- c. In the event of two or more teams having the same number of points, classification will be made according to the quotient of sets won and lost in all matches.
- d. In the event that after the above mentioned, equality still exists between teams, classification will be made according to the quotient of points won and lost in all matches
- e. In the event of two or more teams obtaining the same sets and points quotient, the better place will be taken by the team winning the game or games between them.
- f. The team placed 1 in the league and the team placed 4 will compete for the first Semi Final. The team placed 2 and the team placed 3 will compete for the second Semi Final.
- g. The winners in the Semi Finals will compete in the Final Game for the title: "18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah Champion".
- h. The losers in the Semi Finals will compete for the third place.
- i. The rest of the teams will be placed according to their league order.

# SYSTEM B - if the number of teams will be 8-12;

- a. The teams will be divided into 2 groups.
- b. Group A will be headed by the first team in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.
- c. The second team in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah will head group B.
- d. The teams placed third in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah will be placed in-group B and the team placed fourth in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah will be placed in-group. A. All the other teams will be placed in the groups by a draw.
- e. In the event that after the draw, one or more teams will not appear and a situation arises whereby a group is short of two teams, the team drawn last will be moved from one group to another.
- f. Teams will be classified in their groups according to their achievements, as described in System A.
- g. The semi-final games will be played on the Cross Knock-out system, i.e., the team placed first in Group A will play against the team placed second in Group B and the team placed second in Group A will play against the team placed first in Group B.
- h. The two winning teams in the semi-finals will play in the final game for  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  places, and the two losing teams in the semi-finals will play for  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  places.
- i. When there is 8 teams the teams placed 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> in each group will play on the same system as described in paragraphs g & h above for places 5-8.

### SYSTEM C - if the number of teams will be 13-15.

- a. The teams will be divided into 3 groups.
- b. Group A will be headed by the first in the  $17^{th}$  Maccabiah, and will include also the team placed 6th in the  $17^{th}$  Maccabiah.
- c. Group B will be headed by the second in the  $17^{th}$  Maccabiah, and will include also the team placed  $5^{th}$  in the  $17^{th}$  Maccabiah.
- d. Group C will be headed by the third in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah, and will include also the team placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.
- e. The rest of the teams will be seeded in the groups by a draw.

In case of 13 teams, Group A will consist in 5 teams, Group B 4 teams and Group C 4 teams.

In case of 14 teams, Group A and B will consist in 5 teams and Group C 4 teams.

In case of 15 teams, Groups A, B and C will consist in 5 teams.

<u>REMARK:</u> if any of the 6 mentioned will not participate in the 16th Maccabiah, one from the other teams will take their place, chosen by a draw.

- f. The first round will be a one-round league system and the teams will be placed accordingly in each group as described in SYSTEM A.
- g. The Quarter-finals will include 8 teams as follows:
  - 1- The first two teams of each group after the round robin.
  - 2- Two out of the three placed 3rd in each group according their record based upon System A.
- In case of 13 teams, the game between the team placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in Group A and the team placed 5<sup>th</sup> in that Group in the league will not count for the purpose of determining the best 3<sup>rd</sup> placed team only.
- In case of 14 teams, the game between the team placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in Groups A and B, and the teams placed 5<sup>th</sup> in those Groups in the league will not count for the purpose of determining the best 3<sup>rd</sup> placed team only.
- h. Quarter-finals Games will be played in a Knock Out System and teams will be seeded by a draw.

- i. In the Semi-finals teams will play as follow:
  - 1- Winner Quarter-final 1 Winner Quarter-final 3
  - 2- Winner Quarter-final 2 Winner Quarter-final 4
- j. Games for places 1 to 4 will be held as follows:

Loser Semi-final 1 - Loser Semi-final 2 for places 3-4.

Winner Semi-final 1 - Winner Semi-final 2 in the Final game for places 1-2.

k. Parallel to the final games, loosers in the quarterfinals will play for places 5-8, as described in par. "h" and "i".

# SYSTEM D - if the number of teams is 16 or more.

a. Teams will be divided into 4 groups with the 8 leading teams from the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah heading the Groups as follows:

Group A: 1st and 8th from the 17th Maccabiah.

Group B: 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> from the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.

Group C: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> from the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.

Group D: 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> from the 17<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah.

The rest of the teams will be seeded into the groups by a draw.

<u>REMARK:</u> If any of the 8 mentioned in the will not participate in the 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah; their place will be taken by one of the other teams, chosen by a draw.

b. The Quarter-finals will include 8 teams (the two first placed in the league) and will play in a Knock-out System as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Group A – 2<sup>nd</sup>. Group C

1<sup>st</sup> Group B – 2<sup>nd</sup> Group D

1st Group C - 2nd Group A

1<sup>st</sup> Group D – 2<sup>nd</sup> Group B

- c. Semi-final games will be held in the "cross" system as follows:
  - 1- Winner 1 vs. Winner 2
  - 2- Winner 3 vs. Winner 4
- d. Games for places 1 to 4 will be held as follows:

Loser Semi-final 1 - Loser Semi-final 2 for places 3-4.

Winner Semi-final 1 - Winner Semi-final 2 in the Final game for places 1-2.

e. Parallel to the final games, the looser's teams in the Quarter-finals will play in the same system for places 5-8.

Loser 1 vs. Loser 2

Loser 3 vs. Loser 4

#### 5. Draw

The draw of the teams in the groups will be a public draw.

#### 6. Referees

The Volleyball Committee will select a Referees' Committee, which in turn will appoint the referees for all the games.

### 7. General

These regulations are but one part of the complete 18<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah regulations, and must be read along with the instructions found in "Basic Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures".

In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the "Basic Regulations", the regulations written here will apply and be binding.
