



XIII PAN-AMERICAN MACCABI GAMES – CHILE 2015
TECHNICAL REGULATIONS
TABLE TENNIS

1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The Sports Committee is responsible for the Table Tennis competitions of the XIII JPM Chile 2015.
- 1.2 Table Tennis competitions will be held according to the regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and supervised by the Chilean Table Tennis Federation.
- 1.3 Participation in the competitions is open to any athlete who is in possession of an official badge issued by the Organizing Committee of the XIII JPM Chile 2015. All participants must be identified before the game and be registered at the control table or with the General Referee.
- 1.4 Table Tennis competitions schedule will be determined by the Sports Committee and delegations and participants will be duly and promptly notified. The Sports Committee is authorized to modify the schedule and its decisions are final. All participants must register before the General Referee before any match.

2. CATEGORIES AND REGISTRATION

- 2.1 Each country may enter up to 5 players per category and gender.
- 2.2 The categories for Tennis participants at the XIII JPM Chile 2015 shall be those contained in the General Regulations

3. COMPETITION SYSTEM

- 3.1 Competition will be held in the singles, doubles, mixed doubles and team modalities, the latter subject to the number of registered participants.



- 3.2 Team competitions will be held in the Davis Cup mode: AX / BY / DOUBLE / AY / BX, with a total of 5 games, being the winner the team that wins at least 3 matches, on a single elimination system.
- 3.3 Doubles competitions will be structured on the basis of single elimination draw.
- 3.4 Single competition may be structured with a single draw or in group, depending on the number of participants. In the group format, the first two of each group will advance to the semifinals and will play on single elimination keys.
- 3.5 All matches will be played to the best of 5 Sets of 11 points each. For each confrontation the following score will apply.
 - 3.5.1 Winner: 2 points
 - 3.5.2 Loser: 1 point.
 - 3.5.3 Loser by W.O.: 0 point.
- 3.6 In the team competition, the result of the series will be determined by the sum of the points scored by each team.
- 3.7 In the event of a tie, classification will be decided according to the following criteria:
 - 3.7.1 Tie between two participants: The result of the match played between them.
 - 3.7.2 Tie between 3 or more participants: The results will be decided in using the following criteria, in the following order:
 - Points.
 - Sets difference (it will be with coefficient).
 - Game points difference (it will be with coefficient).
 - Draw.

4. SPECIFIC RULES

- 4.1 Players who participate in team competitions must have the same color of shirt. Players participating in doubles must have the same color of shirt. In singles an athlete can play with any shirt. Players cannot use training suits to play.



- 4.2 It is forbidden to advertise alcoholic beverages, cigarettes or other goods that may be harmful for health in the clothing.
- 4.3 The non-appearance of any of the players will be considered a "walk over", losing the confrontation.

5. REFEREES

- 5.1 The Sports Committee shall delegate to the Chilean Table Tennis Federation the designation of the Referees, judges and technical staff.
- 5.2 All games will be directed by first Category Chilean referees or by foreign judges with a similar quality. No referee or judge may be challenged by any participating country.

6. GENERAL

- 6.1 These Technical Regulations are part of the General Regulations of the XIII JPM Chile 2015 and should be read with the instructions contained in the regulations of each sport.
- 6.2 In the event of discrepancies between the rules here written and those that appear in the General Regulations, these written provisions shall prevail.
- 6.3 The Organizing Committee of the XIII JPM Chile 2015, through its Sports Committee, is authorized to make changes or modifications it deems appropriate in the present Technical Regulations.
- 6.4 Cases not specified in these Technical Regulations, shall be decided by the Organizing Committee of the XIII JPM Chile 2015, through its Sports Committee.
